

Transfer Tests



50% Math and 50% English

28 questions in the English section, broken down into:

- Punctuation exercise - 5 questions equating to 9%.
 - Grammar exercise - 5 questions equating to 9%.
 - Spelling exercise - 5 questions equating to 9%.
 - Comprehension exercise - 13 questions with 7 multiple choice and 6 free response (writing the answer down) and this will equate to 23%.
